## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FLOWER PLACEMENT**

### **Lawn Sections:**

All flowers will be removed every Thursday for mowing.

Artificial and fresh flowers may be placed on in-ground graves, in a pre-purchased flower urn, approved by or purchased through the District. Once the flowers start to discolor, fade or deteriorate, cemetery employees will dispose of them.

### **Sections with above ground stones:**

Flowers can only be placed on above ground markers with built in flower urns and / or an approved, pre-purchased flower urn, as to not interfere with mowing. Employees will dispose of any flowers that are dead or unsightly or any other items placed without written permission from the District.

### **All Sections:**

All other forms of grave decorations will be removed. These include, but are not limited to, glass jars, artificial grass, spikes, food cans, decorative rocks, breakable items (i.e. glass, porcelain), no fire burning objects, specifically **CANDLES** and other objects not approved or that would interfere with mowing, maintenance and SAFETY will be removed, *immediately*. **ONLY PLASTIC or SPECIFICALLY GALVANIZED METAL FLOWER VASES FOR CEMETERIES WILL BE PERMITTED, UNLESS THERE IS ALREADY A FLOWER VASE BUILT INTO YOUR MARKER.**

Every reasonable effort will be made to care for flowers and containers placed on graves. Neither the Cemetery District nor its employees will be responsible for anything of a movable character that may be lost, stolen, or misplaced.

### **Niches:**

Only niche vases are allowed in the columbarium.

### **Holiday Flowers:**

Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day and Thanksgiving will be removed seven (7) days after the holiday. All Christmas decoration will be permitted December 1<sup>st</sup> through January 15<sup>th</sup>.

**All flowers will be removed from graves twice a year for general clean-up.  
Cemetery management retains the right to remove all flowers and decorations at any time.
